NORTHEAST OHIO MEDICAL UNIVERSITY DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

Doctor of Medicine (M.D.)

The degree curriculum fuses behavioral, biological, clinical, community health and social sciences with the humanities. Students are grounded in the complex interplay of these disciplines as they pertain to patient care and health outcomes.

COLLEGE OF PHARMACY

Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.)

This program offers an interprofessional curriculum that blends classroom and practice experiences to provide the knowledge, skills and professionalism that is necessary to succeed as a pharmacist.

COLLEGE OF GRADUATE STUDIES

Doctor of Philosophy in Integrated Pharmaceutical Medicine

This program educates and develops independent scientists and scholars with a unique cross-disciplinary perspective bridging pharmaceutical sciences with medical disciplines, with a focus on advancement of disease mechanisms and targets for therapeutic interventions.

Master of Arts in Medical Ethics and Humanities

In this program, students critically examine and apply ethical and health humanities-based theories, concepts, and issues. Students gain experience toward their professional development as health care professionals, clinical ethicists, humanities scholars, and bioethicists.

Master of Leadership in Health Systems Science

This degree program teaches how the aims of health science work together to better achieve enhanced patient experience within health systems, including improved patient and population health, reduced cost and better work-life balance for practitioners.

Master of Public Health

A program that provides graduates with a foundation of public health skills and knowledge, including analytic skills, research strategies, community assessment methods, program implementation, evaluation and policy development within an ethical and culturally sensitive perspective.

Master of Science in Health-System Pharmacy Administration

This degree program is designed for individuals who wish to build on their professional competence and enables them to manage complex health-system pharmacy departments at the institutional and departmental levels.

Master of Science in Integrative Pharmacy Medicine Innovation

With a focus on medical device innovation, this program offers a unique blend of drug discovery, therapeutics and research methods that are critical to solving clinical problems. Students develop innovative solutions to unmet medical needs and prepare them for commercial markets.

Master in Foundations of Medicine

This degree program is designed to introduce students to fundamental concepts in the biomedical sciences as well as provide clinical and research experiences.

Global Health Certificate

Provides learning opportunities in global and underserved health with a goal to overcome existing challenges through unconventional and innovative solutions.

Health Research Certificate

Provides students with essential research knowledge and training, competitive skills useful for recruitment in post-graduate programs, and early career grant funding.

Medical Ethics and Humanities Certificate

This program is designed to combine clinical practice with ethics consultation, education and research.

The academic regalia worn at commencement is of medieval origin and dates back to the 11th century. The scholars of Bologna, Salamanca, Paris, Oxford, Cambridge, Louvain and Heidelberg dressed in a manner that would distinguish them from merchants and other townspeople.

The gown originally may have been worn to keep the teachers warm in unheated classrooms. The gowns of bachelor's and master's degree recipients are usually black without trimmings. The front of the doctoral gowns are faced with velvet and adorned with three velvet bars on the sleeves.

The hood is lined with colors that denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree. The colors of the hood are those of the college or university from which the degree is granted. The length of the hood is correspondingly longer with each advanced degree and is placed on doctoral candidates by faculty hooders and worn by masters candidates during the hooding ceremony.

The Northeast Ohio Medical University hood was designed to reflect the colors of the University, blue and silver.

The gold cords worn by selected faculty members identify those individuals who have been designated **NEOMED Master Teachers**. This honor recognizes faculty who have consistently excelled at advancing the art and scholarship of teaching and who have developed innovative teaching methods within the medical profession.

The green and gold braided cords worn by members of the graduating class of the College of Medicine identify those who are **Alpha Omega Alpha** members.

The white cords worn by members of the graduating class of the College of Medicine identify those who have been inducted into the **NEOMED Virtuous Healer Honor Society**.

The purple and white cords worn by members of the graduating class of the College of Pharmacy identify those who are **Rho Chi** members.

The yellow and green cords worn by members of the graduating class of the College of Pharmacy identify those who are **Phi Lambda Sigma** members.

Graduating Black students wear **Kente stoles** as a sign of their successful matriculation through higher education and the transformation of their bodies into living, breathing proverbs. This tradition of marking oneself with a visible sign of Africa is a practice that literally weaves together the wisdom of Africa before the Middle Passage with the persistent struggle to (re)attain knowledge of oneself that defines the Black experience in the Diaspora.

Dr. Rosenthal's book, An American Sickness: How Healthcare Became Big Business and How You Can Take It Back, was a New York Times bestseller and a Washington Post notable book of the year. She is a graduate of Stanford University and Harvard Medical School and briefly practiced medicine in a New York City emergency room before converting to journalism.

Dr. Malone is a professor of psychiatry at the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine of Case Western Reserve University. Dr. Malone previously served as president of Cleveland Clinic Lutheran Hospital as well as chair of the Department of Psychiatry and Psychology at Cleveland Clinic where he also directed the Center for Behavioral Health. He also serves as chair of the Cleveland Clinic Strategic Space Planning Committee and a member of the Cleveland Clinic Planning Committee. Dr. Malone graduated with his M.D. from Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine in 1985, where he was a member of Alpha Omega Alpha. Following his medical school training, he did one year of internship in internal medicine followed by a psychiatric residency at The Massachusetts General Hospital.

He has been with The Cleveland Clinic since 1989. Dr. Malone has been very active in research, education, and various local and national committees. He has held positions in the Ohio Psychiatric Association, the American Psychiatric Association, the International Society for Neurostimulation, and the American College of Psychiatrists. His research has been primarily in the areas of anxiety disorders, anabolic steroid use and abuse, neuromodulation, and Deep Brain Stimulation. He has authored numerous publications in these areas and presented both nationally and internationally.


