4:20 p.m 5:00 p.m.	6	Open Forum and Department updates from Council members	Dr. Mellott reminded the faculty members of the UFC special meeting on Tuesday, Nov. 21 with Provost Faison and General Counsel and encouraged their attendance. The meeting is to discuss the workload policy before it is presented to the Board of Trustees at the end of November. Dr. Mellott shared the following reminders with the faculty. Open enrolment for health benefits – deadline is Friday, Nov. 17 Student Research Symposium – Friday, Nov. 17 2023 Faculty Recognition Awards – deadline for nominations is Friday, Dec. 1 Dr. Mellott will be meeting with Mary Taylor to review the faculty empowerment plan to include service and ensure there is no loss of salary. There will be no further pilots after July 2024 and once faculty are enrolled in the plan, they are committed to it. Dr. Mellott asked the faculty to reach out to him with any concerns. JEDD Income Tax Dr. Mellott provided an update from the EMT meeting regarding the JEDD income tax announcement. He conveyed that the majority of faculty and staff will likely remain unaffected by these changes. Individuals residing in cities already subject to taxation will not pay more than 2%. Mary Taylor will be sending an updated announcement with clearer language and some examples of how it will work. Dr. Mellott invited faculty to share their thoughts to be brought back to the administration. Dr. DeLucio asked what benefits are we gaining. How is the township utilizing the funds? There's an opportunity to reevaluate

	and potentially enhance our relationship, promoting NEOMED as a positive force within the community,
	Dr. Yin expressed concerns about potential double taxation. In response, Dr. Everly recommended reaching out to RITA (Regional Income Tax Authority) to seek clarification and answers
	Dr. Mellott said the EMT felt strongly that most faculty/staff would not be affected.
	Senate Bill 83 The approval of the bill is expected in December. The language to prevent faculty from striking has been removed.
	The meeting was adjourned at 4:21 p.m.
