NORTHEAST OHIO MEDICAL UNIVERSITY DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES

COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

Doctor of Medicine (M.D.)

The degree curriculum fuses behavioral, biological, clinical, community health and social sciences with the humanities. Students are grounded in the complex interplay of these disciplines as they pertain to patient care and health outcomes.

COLLEGE OF PHARMACY

Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.)

This program offers an interprofessional curriculum that blends classroom and practice experiences to provide the knowledge, skills and professionalism that is necessary to succeed as a pharmacist.

COLLEGE OF GRADUATE STUDIES

Doctor of Philosophy or Master of Science in Integrated Pharmaceutical Medicine

Doctor of Philosophy or Master of Science in Integrated Pharmaceutical Medicine programs educate and develop independent scientists and scholars with unique cross-disciplinary perspective bridging pharmaceutical sciences with medical disciplines, with a focus on advancement of disease mechanisms and targets for therapeutic interventions.

Master of Arts in Medical Ethics and Humanities

In this program students critically examine and apply ethical and health humanities-based theories, concepts, and issues relevant to global health; illness and disease; medical culture and practice; social justice; health policy and law; literature and media. Students gain experience toward their professional development as health care professionals, clinical ethicists, humanities scholars, and bioethicists.

Master of Leadership in Health Systems Science

This degree program teaches how the aims of health science work together to better achieve enhanced patient experience within health systems, including improved patient and population health, reduced cost and better work-life balance for practitioners.

Master of Public Health

A program that provides graduates with a foundation of public health skills and knowledge, including analytic skills, research strategies, community assessment methods, program implementation, evaluation and policy development within an ethical and culturally sensitive perspective.

Master of Science in Health-System Pharmacy Administration

The degree program is designed for individuals who wish to build on their professional competence and enables them to manage complex health-system pharmacy departments at the institutional and departmental levels.

Master of Science in Integrated Pharmaceutical Medicine

The main objective of the degree program is to educate and develop first-rate scholars and independent investigators within an integrated curriculum. Graduates of this program will have a unique perspective on the linkage of pharmaceutical sciences to medical disciplines, especially regarding disease mechanisms and targets for therapeutic interventions.

Master of Modern Anatomical Sciences

This program is designed to train the next generation of anatomists and anatomy educators by providing a high volume of hands-on experience in a research setting and the opportunity to work and learn as part of an interprofessional team with health care professionals.

Health Research Certificate

This program provides students with an opportunity to enhance their professional education or to serve as a pathway toward graduate education in health sciences.

Medical Ethics and Humanities Certificate

This program is designed to combine clinical practice with ethics consultation, education and research.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn at commencement is of medieval origin and dates back to the 11th century. The scholars of Bologna, Salamanca, Paris, Oxford, Cambridge, Louvain and Heidelberg dressed in a manner that would distinguish them from merchants and other townspeople.

The gown originally may have been worn to keep the teachers warm in unheated classrooms. The gowns of bachelor's and master's degree recipients are usually black without trimmings. The front of the doctoral gowns are faced with velvet and adorned with three velvet bars on the sleeves.

The hood is lined with colors that denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree. The colors of the hood are those of the college or university from which the degree is granted. The length of the hood is correspondingly longer with each advanced degree and is placed on doctoral candidates by faculty hooders and worn by masters candidates during the hooding ceremony.

The Northeast Ohio Medical University hood was designed to reflect the colors of the University, blue and silver.

Chander M. Kohli, M.D.

Dr. Kohli is the senior neurosurgeon at St. Elizabeth Medical Center and has served in this capacity for close to 50 years. He is also affiliated with St. Joseph Hospital since 1999 and Forum, Valley Care and Steward since 1972. Dr. Kohli is certified by the American Board of Neurological Surgeons since 1975; is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons since 1976, a Fellow of the American College of International Physicians since 1991, and a Fellow of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons since 2010.

Dr. Kohli received his bachelor's degree at Hindu College in Delhi, India and his medical degree at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India; served his rotating internship and surgical residency

at Memorial Hospital, Elyria, Ohio, and completed his neurosurgical residency at the University of Alberta Hospital, Alberta, Canada and his residency training at the Mercy Hospital, University of Pittsburgh.

Dr. Kohli served as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Northeast Ohio Medical University from September 22, 2000 through June 30, 2005; December 21, 2008 through September 22, 2012; and September 22, 2012 through September 21, 2021. He has served as the longest standing trustee in NEOMED's history and in the capacity as an advocate and friend of the University's students, faculty and staff.

Dr. Kohli is widely respected by his profession and has served in many capacities including president of medical staff, clinical executive committee, vice president of medical staff, clinical executive committee, assistant director of surgical services, and director — Section of Neurosurgery at St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center; President of the Mahoning Medical Sociate; Delegate to the Ohio State Medical Association (OSMA) Mahoning County Medical Society; President, Ohio Chapter, American College of International Physicians; and President and Founder of the American Association of South Asian Neurosurgeons.

Dr. Kohli is committed to service and has been an active participant with many professional organizations including chairman and board member of the India Association of Greater Youngstown; board of directors of Sky Bank (now known as Huntington Bank); chairman and board member of the Youngstown State University board of trustees; board member of the Humility of Mary Health Services; vice chairperson and board member of the St. Elizabeth Foundation; board member of the American College of International Physicians; board member of the MRI Co-Operative; and board member of the American Association of South Asian Neurosurgeons.

Dr. Kohli was honored by many organizations including the Personalities of the West and Midwest; Man of the Year Award for community service by the India Association of Greater Youngstown; Distinguished Service Award by the American College of International Physicians; Physician Recognition Award by the Mahoning County Medical Society; Outstanding Achievement Award from the Youngstown AAPI Chapter; Community Service Award from Ohio Governor Robert Taft; Community Service Award from the Secretary of State Kenneth Blackwell; President and Dean's Award and the award of Distinguished Professor of Neurosurgery from Northeast Ohio Medical University; Award of Excellence, Outreach and Commitment from the Asian Indian Alliance of Ohio; American Cancer Society Honor Award at the 6th Annual Cattle Baron's Ball; and Commencement and Keynote Speaker at Avalon University. In addition, Dr. and Mrs. Kohli were recognized by Youngstown State University on Aug. 27, 2021, by having Kohli Hall, which houses the Excellence Training Center (ETC), named in their honor in recognition of their \$5 million in donations to the university's "We See Tomorrow" fundraising campaign.

Dr. Kohli, his wife Karen, and their daughter, Nisha, are committed to the mission and success of NEOMED and its students, faculty and staff and have provided support to the University's academic programs, academic technology, diversity initiatives, presidential initiatives and scholarship.

Duane J. Taylor, M.D. ('85)

Duane J. Taylor, M.D. ('85) has been in practice in the Greater Washington Area for over 30 years with specialties in otolaryngologyhead and neck surgery and facial plastic and reconstructive surgery. He is a graduate of the combined University of Akron, NEOMED B.S./M.D. As a student, he served as the second president of the Student National Medical Association and was recognized by the American Diabetes Association for a diabetes screening program in the African American churches in Summit County. He also served as a mentor and teacher for a minority and rural student program for high school students. He was selected to participate in an ophthalmology humanitarian medical mission to Ecuador, conducted a plastic surgery research project with

James Lehman, M.D., at Akron City Hospital, served as a summer research program coordinator and did an American Society of Anesthesiology preceptorship. After graduation he completed a surgery internship at the St. Joseph University of Texas Affiliated Hospital in Houston, followed by a residency in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery at the King/Drew Medical Center in Los Angeles where he was chief resident, and named resident of the year twice. Dr. Taylor did a fellowship in facial plastic and reconstructive surgery in Washington, D.C. through the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is currently in private practice in Bethesda, Maryland, a division of the Centers for Advanced ENT Care and serves as a clinical instructor for medical students and residents from George Washington University and Georgetown University. He is on the clinical attending staffs for Johns Hopkins Suburban Hospital, Trinity Holy Cross Hospitals and Medstar Washington Hospital Center.

From 2019-2020 he served with distinction as the President of the American Academy of Otolaryngology—Head and Neck Surgery/Foundation, the largest organization of this specialty in the world with over 12,000 members. During his tenure as president he led and navigated his specialty through the COVID-19 pandemic on a local and international level, with some of the many accomplishments including creating an anosmia tool and being the leading voice on anosmia as a symptom of COVID, creation of a COVID-19 podcast series, guidance on quality and safety measures as well as bringing the Global Otolaryngology Community together. Also, during the year, as the first African American president in the Academy's 125 year history, he led his specialty through a heightened awareness in the areas of social justice and health equity. For many years he has been a champion in the areas of diversity and inclusion and physician wellness.

Locally he has served as the president of the Montgomery County Medical Society, on the Montgomery County Health Commission, Montgomery Cares Advisory Board, the Mid Atlantic Permanent Board of Directors, Medical Society of DC Board, Medico Chirurgical Society Board, and as Region 2 Chair of the National Medical Association. He has received numerous honors over the years including: the AAO-HNSF Presidential Citation, Distinguished Service and Honors awards, membership in the Alpha Omega Alpha Medical Honor Society, American Red Cross Real Heroes Award, *Washingtonian Magazine* Top Doctor, Med Chi of DC Pillars of the Community Award, Minority Access National Role Model Mentor Award, induction in the Shaker Heights Alumni Hall of Fame and the Hinton-Gladney award.



C. Forrest Faison III, M.D., Sc.D. (hon), FAAP Vice Admiral (ret.), Medical Corps, U.S. Navy

Vice Adm. Forrest Faison is a native of Norfolk, Virginia, and received his baccalaureate degree from Wake Forest University. He was commissioned in 1980, and earned his doctorate degree in medicine and surgery from the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in 1984. He completed post-graduate training in general pediatrics at Naval Hospital San Diego and fellowship training in neurodevelopmental pediatrics at the University of Washington.

Dr. Faison served as commander, Navy Medicine West and Naval Medical Center San Diego where he was responsible for medical care and support

to over 850,000 eligible beneficiaries by a staff of 16,000 at 10 hospitals and more than 30 clinics from the West Coast to the Indian Ocean. He served as deputy chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery, for Current and Future Healthcare Operations; commanding officer Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton; commanding officer, U.S. Expeditionary Medical Facility; and U.S. Medical Task Force, Kuwait. In that role, Faison led a tri-service task force of subordinate commands and was responsible for all health care operations in Kuwait, Qatar, and Southern Iraq; including all medical logistics support throughout U.S. Central Command.

Dr. Faison's other assignments include deputy commander, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Portsmouth, Virginia; Group Surgeon, 3d Force Service Support Group, Fleet Marine Forces, Pacific; director of Department of Defense Telemedicine, Washington, D.C.; chief information officer, Navy Medicine; director, clinical services, U.S. Naval Hospital Yokosuka, Japan; Naval Hospital Lemoore; USS Texas (CGN 39); and Amphibious Group 3.

Dr. Faison is board certified, and an associate clinical professor in pediatrics and a distinguished professor of military medicine at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. He has several publications on neurodevelopmental outcomes of premature infants as well as other publications and book chapters on the topics of the future of Wounded Warrior, use of telemedicine and health informatics in health care, and value-based care. He is a senior member of the American Associates for Physician Leadership and guest lecturer at Harvard Business School. Dr. Faison served as the deputy surgeon general of the Navy and deputy chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery from 2013 to 2015 and began serving as the 38th surgeon general of the Navy in 2015. In addition to numerous unit and campaign awards, Dr. Faison's personal awards include the Navy Distinguished Service Medal (two awards), Legion of Merit (six awards); Meritorious Service Medal (three awards); Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal; and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal. For coordinating Navy Medicine's support response to Operation Tomodachi, he was awarded the California Medical Community's Lighthouse Award for visionary leadership and inspiring health innovation; a first for the Department of Defense. Additionally, the Government of Japan awarded Dr. Faison the Japanese Maritime Self-Defense Force Commendation Medal for his support and collaboration in medical education and research.


