



## **Campus Safety Expectations Northeast Ohio Medical University**

In order to minimize the risks associated with the spread of the novel coronavirus infection, COVID-19, Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) is imposing the following safety expectations upon all students, employees, and visitors to the NEOMED campus. We appreciate your adherence to these expectations in order to keep the NEOMED campus a safe place to live, learn, work and conduct business.

Student, employees, or visitors to the NEOMED campus should refrain from coming to campus if they have any of the following:

- Fever of 100.4 F (38 C) or above, or possible fever symptoms like alternating chills and sweating
- Cough
- Trouble breathing, shortness of breath or severe wheezing
- Muscle aches
- Sore throat
- Loss of smell or taste, or a change in taste
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Headache unrelated to a previously diagnosed condition

While on the NEOMED campus, student, employees and visitors must:

- Practice **physical distancing** by ensuring a 6 foot distance between people at all times, which includes **following all directional signs** and **leaving all chairs and furniture** in place to abide with physical distancing
- Wear a **cloth face covering** to/from their vehicle and at all times while on campus, unless they are alone in an enclosed space
- Engage in **regular handwashing for 20 seconds** or frequent hand sanitizing utilizing
- **Cover all coughs or sneezes** with a tissue or use the inside of the elbow
- Abide by **occupancy limitations** in place on all rooms or areas on campus
