Introduction

Students are responsible for registering themselves for all relevant coursework within established deadlines with the exception of cross-registered courses taken at other universities or those that require faculty approval like Practicum or Independent Study. These will be added administratively once the approval process is complete. These forms are available on our website at <http://www.neomed.edu/registrar/annual-registration/course-registration/>.

Registration for Fall 2019 courses opens **June 17, 2019**. The Drop/Add period, which ends course registration ends on **September 4, 2019**. Please note that student bills are generated approximately 10 days before the first day of the semester; students are strongly encouraged to complete registration in advance of this to ensure an accurate and complete bill.

Using the Online Registration System

1. Go to “Banner Self-Service” (typically on the “My Services” tab). Select the “Student Information Menu”, then “Registration Menu”
2. Click “Add/Drop Classes”. If prompted, choose the term (“**Fall 2019**”; 201980) – Dual Enrolled M3 or M4 students should select “**Clinical Term AY 19-20**”; 202099”
3. If you have the CRN for the classes, you may enter those into the boxes at the bottom. (The CRNs/Course Reference Numbers are available in the attached catalog). Otherwise, use the “Class Search” to locate courses you’re interested in.
4. When you’re finished, click “Submit”
5. You can make any changes you wish during the registration period. **You must be registered for classes by the end of the registration period.**
6. **Course times are subject to change – Banner Self-service during registration will be updated.**
