## **Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) Higher Education Course - Registration FAQ**

### **How do I register for the course?**

You may register by visiting <https://www.neomed.edu/csmh/training-opportunities/> and clicking on the registration link for your desired training date.

### **What happens after I register?**

No later than 48 hours before the course, you will receive an email from MHFA Connect prompting you to register an account. This account is required to access course materials and certification components.

### **Will there be pre-work required?**

Yes. Before the course, you must complete:

- The MHFA Pre-Evaluation, and
- The MHFA Opinions Survey

### **Will breaks be offered during the day?**

Yes. A 30-minute lunch break will be provided, along with multiple short breaks throughout the day. Participants are also encouraged to take additional breaks as needed.

### **Is there a cost to attend?**

At this time, the Mental Health First Aid for Higher Education course offered through the Ohio Program for Campus Safety and Mental Health is fully funded by the Ohio Department of Behavioral Health and is available at no cost to interested members of Ohio's campus communities. The current value of this training is approximately \$125.

### **Who is this course for?**

This course is designed specifically for those working with or within higher education environments, including:

- Students
- Faculty & staff
- Counseling and wellness providers
- Administrators
- Campus partners
