AN UPDATE FROM THE AMERICAN FOUNDATION FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION: SUICIDE PREVENTION ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES

Suicide is a significant public health issue on college campuses impacting tens of thousands of students each year. Dr. Standley is a community psychologist and researcher with over a decade of experience in schools, health systems, and communities. His work focuses on public health and community-level approaches to suicide prevention through capacity building, equitable systems change, and policy change. In this presentation, Dr. Standley will discuss the scope of the issue and what college and university campuses, faculty, and staff can do to support students. The importance of prioritizing diversity, equity, and inclusion, as well as community collaboration, will also be discussed. Finally, Dr. Standley will share insights and ideas about what the future of suicide prevention on college campuses can look like.
