

Preface

This report is an historic record of all professionals trained in the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Patrol Officer Training Course, from 2000-2023 and demonstrates the strength of the core elements and the CIT Model.

This section is a guide to understand the various illustrations, icons, and abbreviations used in this document. The executive summary presents aggregate statewide training progress. Following this, the content of this report is then organized alphabetically by Ohio's fifty Alcohol Drug Addiction and Mental Health Service Board areas with primary CIT Program Coordinator(s) listed on their respective program page. CIT training records for communities without an active program, as well as the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, are located on the final pages. A CIT program coordinator directory is located at the very end of this report.



At the top of each program page, for applicable counties, CIT peer reviews and Sequential Intercept Mapping (SIM) exercises are marked by gold and silver stars. For stars representing SIM, the year of their occurrence corresponds to a color based on the type of mapping (mental health, opiate, or juvenile). See above. The next section of each program page contains law enforcement jurisdictions' training counts in a table, followed by county details in blue boxes. At the bottom, a chart shows participation by all professions for CIT Patrol Officer Training Courses.

This report uses jurisdictions and full-time officer position counts listed in the 2021 County Agency Report developed by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC). Sworn officers' training data are counted in a single jurisdiction and county as listed in the OPOTC report, even if the jurisdiction crosses county lines. Each person is counted within the agency they were present at the time of their training, not accounting for agency transfers, or training outside of their county of employment. Earlier editions of this report showed progress for CIT programs using a running count. In the migration to a comprehensive trainee database, we used original rosters to prove attendance. Subsequently, in some jurisdictions, we found we had higher counts of trained officers left unmatched to rosters in our archives. Those differences are preserved in any applicable jurisdiction. Other key items:

- Jurisdiction totals in red are those with higher counts of officers left unmatched to rosters in our archives
- New or newly participating jurisdictions for each calendar year are in blue
- Counties with Stepping Up Initiative commitments have their jurisdiction table in green

A Note from the Executive Director

The Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) is a community partnership program with law enforcement, mental health, community, and advocacy partnerships. The CIT model was first developed in Memphis, TN in 1988 and was implemented in two Ohio counties in 2000.

The CIT Core Elements exist to support and guide CIT Programs toward success. The basic goals of a Crisis Intervention Team are to improve officer and consumer safety and redirect individuals with mental illness from the criminal justice system to the health care system.

One core element of CIT is training. The training element of the CIT program is based on the Crisis Intervention Team Patrol Officer Training Course, which educates law enforcement and first responders on how to assist individuals living with mental illness who are experiencing a crisis in the community. This is typically a 40-hour, community-based course designed to increase knowledge and understanding of mental illness, decrease stigma and increase empathy for those with an illness, introduce community resources and partners that can assist in effective responses to community members, and build listening, communication, and de-escalation skills that are effective in encounters with individuals in mental health crises.

Today, all 88 Ohio counties have participated in CIT training, although a handful of counties have not implemented fully operational programs which incorporate additional core elements. Ohio is striving for all communities to have access to effective law enforcement responses for individuals and families experiencing mental health crises, when such a response is necessary, and for all law enforcement officers to have adequate training and support to best serve community members with mental illness and their families. This report is limited to the training element of our Ohio programs. 
Executive Summary

In Ohio, CIT training has equipped thousands of individuals with skills to assist those experiencing mental health crises. Based on training rosters submitted to the CJ CCoE, we can confirm 15,825 sworn personnel trained in CIT and an additional 6,550 professionals trained across Ohio's 88 counties <u>and beyond</u>. Ohio's CIT programs have trained a total of 22,375 people, 49 of whom traveled across the globe to attend one of our trainings. According to the 2021 Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission report, there are 950 law enforcement jurisdictions; of those 78% (743) participate in CIT training, leaving 207 agencies or 22% that have not yet participated in CIT.


40-Hour CIT Patrol Officer Training Course Participation Trends* May 2000 - March 2023




Participation by Profession May 2000 - March 2023



A variety of agency types have sent individuals to a CIT Patrol Officers Training Course (full course). Of all CIT training courses, this is the course most frequently attended. Originally and for a number of years, the focus of this course was solely on sworn law enforcement. As CIT programs have grown and evolved in Ohio, we have seen an increase in a variety of professions who value the experience of this training: public safety telecommunicators, emergency medical technicians, and corrections personnel, to name a few. This adds to the character and depth of CIT programs by equipping law enforcement with support personnel throughout the community and their local crisis response system.




