Campus-Community Collaborative Grant **Grantee One Page Summary**

OhioGuidestone

The purpose of these grants is to promote collaboration between college/university and community stakeholders to develop programming to prevent suicide, promote mental health and reduce stigma about mental illness or its treatment on campus.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

OhioGuidestone (OGS) will collaborate with Stark State College to raise awareness of mental health services on Stark State's Summit County campus. Stark State College has collaborated with OhioGuidestone for over three years, most recently collaborating on a Rise and Thrive initiative building more collaboration between community partners and the university to better serve student mental health needs. OhioGuidestone staff member will spend 40 staff hours working with Stark State staff members to conduct monthly events to raise awareness of mental health supports and services available to students, and to help reduce the stigma of seeking mental health services on campus.
