

CIRCUMSTANTIAL MEMBERSHIP POLICY**Policy 2**

Revised and Amended 9/29/2016

R.A.N. has had a circumstantial membership policy in effect since its inception in 1999. The purpose of this policy is to accommodate any member(s) who may experience financial difficulty paying annual or life membership dues.

Should a member feel he/she needs assistance, they may approach an officer of R.A.N. or the NEOMED staff liaison to request circumstantial membership.

Following approval, forgiveness of membership dues payments will remain in effect until a R.A.N. officer/NEOMED staff liaison is notified that the member's circumstances have changed and said member can resume the payment of annual dues.

The R.A.N. officers, along with NEOMED and the NEOMED Foundation, are aware that personal vicissitude can affect a retirees' ability to budget nonessential expenses. It is R.A.N.'s objective that all retirees have the opportunity to join the organization and are comfortable with their membership in R.A.N.
