Introduction

Summer 1: Tuesday, June 4

Full Summer Term: Friday, June 7

Summer 2: Wednesday, July 17

Using the Online Registration System

1. Go to “Banner Self-Service” (typically on the “My Services” tab). Select the “Student Information Menu”, then “Registration Menu”
2. Click “Add/Drop Classes”. If prompted, choose the term (**Summer 2019**)
3. If you have the CRN for the classes, you may enter those into the boxes at the bottom. (The CRNs/Course Reference Numbers are available in the attached catalog). Otherwise, use the “Class Search” to locate courses you’re interested in.
4. When you’re finished, click “Submit”
5. You can make any changes you wish during the registration period. **You must be registered for classes by the end of the registration period.**

These students should complete the [necessary form](#) (after which they will be administratively registered).

Registration periods typically open about two months before the semester begins, with established add/drop periods that allow students to experience courses before making a final decision. Specific dates and deadlines for each semester are published on this website and distributed via email. Students are encouraged to register no later than two weeks before the start of the semester to ensure accurate and complete billing.
