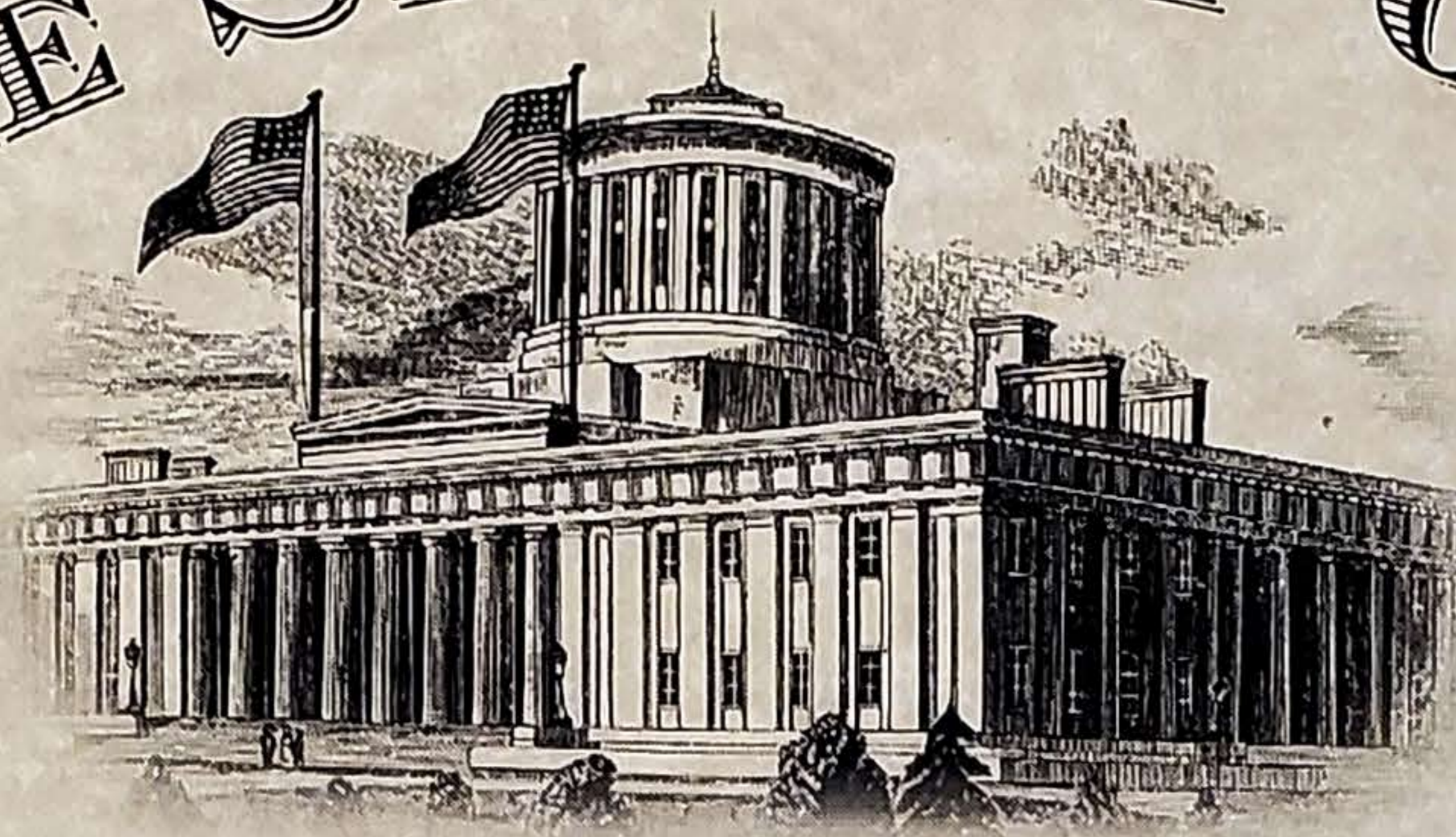



on being presented with the 2021 Friend of Family Medicine Award by the Ohio Academy of Family Physicians.


