Introduction

This report presents College of Dentistry applicant, matriculant, and enrollment data for Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) for academic year 2025–2026, the College's inaugural year of operation. Multi-year trend data are not yet available. Data are drawn from official Fall Census enrollment records and admissions data.

BCOD Applicants and Matriculants by Academic Year

The visualization below uses a combo chart format. Grouped bars display the total number of applicants (navy) and matriculants (teal) for each academic year (2025–2026, the College's inaugural year). A dashed amber trend line connects the matriculant values to highlight change over time.

FIGURE 1: Applicant and Matriculant Trends During Academic Year 2025-2026 (Inaugural Year)

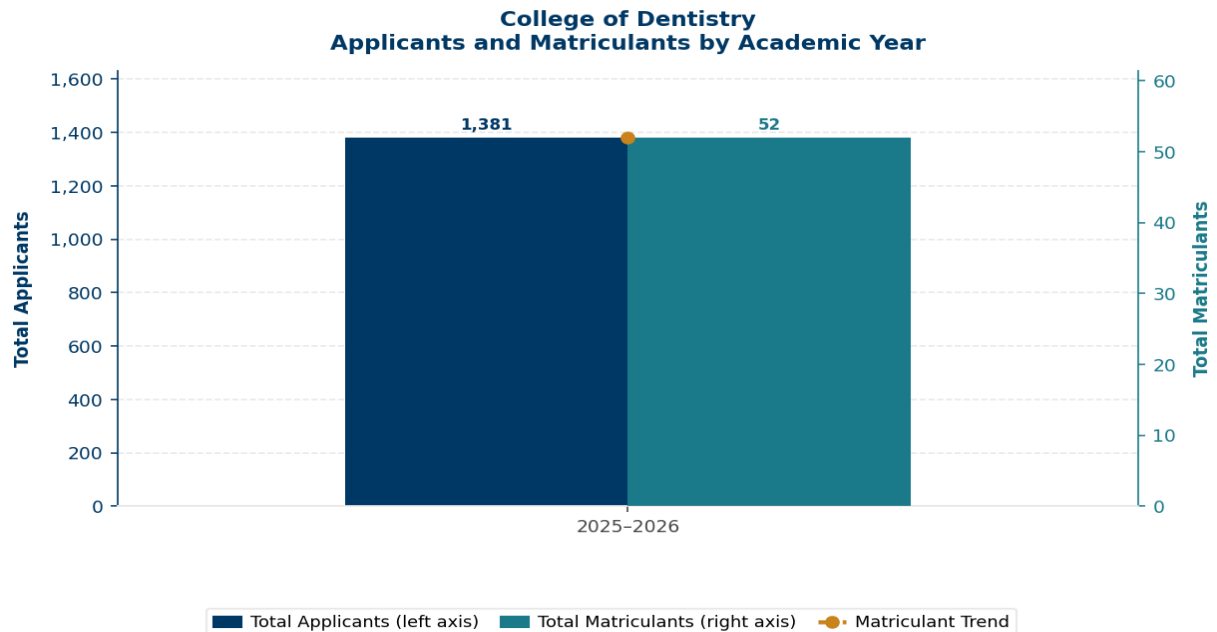


Figure 1. College of Dentistry — Total Applicants and Matriculants, 2025–2026. Bars represent applicant (navy) and matriculant (teal) counts per academic year. Dashed amber line shows the matriculant trend. The complete data set is provided in Table 1.

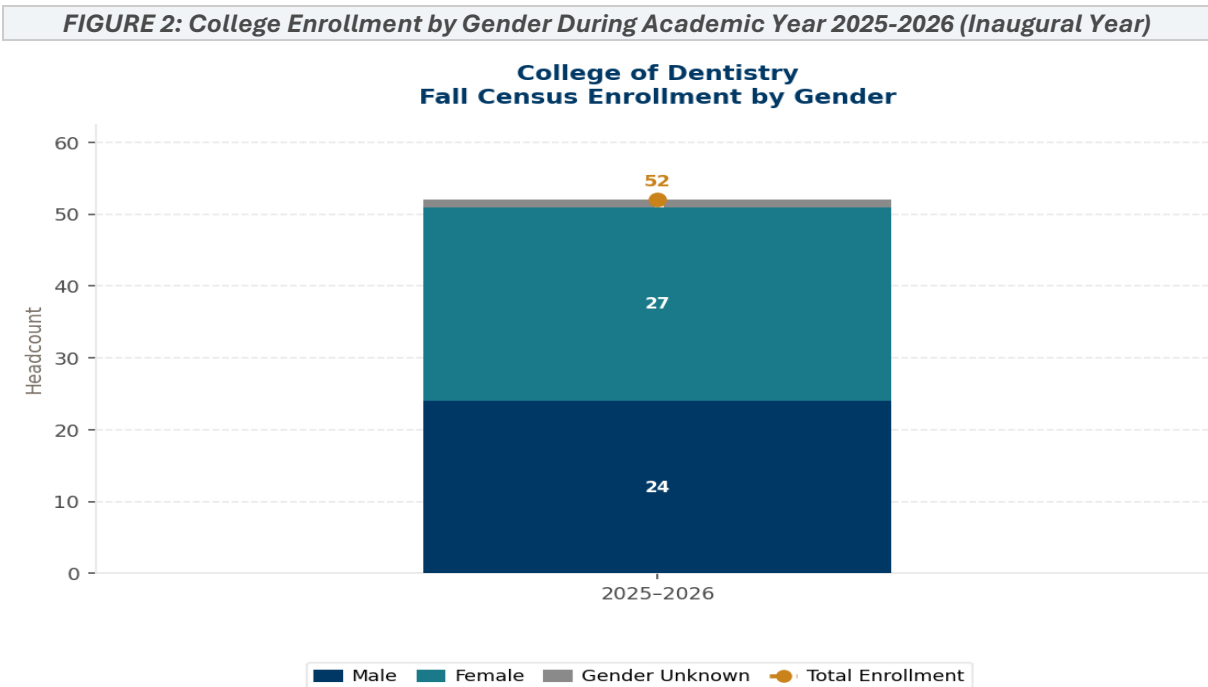


Figure 2. College of Dentistry — Fall Census Enrollment by Gender, 2025-2026. Stacked bars represent Male (navy), Female (teal), and Gender Unknown (gray) enrollment counts per academic year. Dashed amber line indicates total enrollment. The complete data set is provided in Table 2.
