Introduction

This report presents average educational debt data for graduates of the NEOMED College of Medicine across five graduation years, from 2021 through 2025. Data are drawn from official university records and national surveys.

Figure 1. Average Educational Debt — College of Medicine

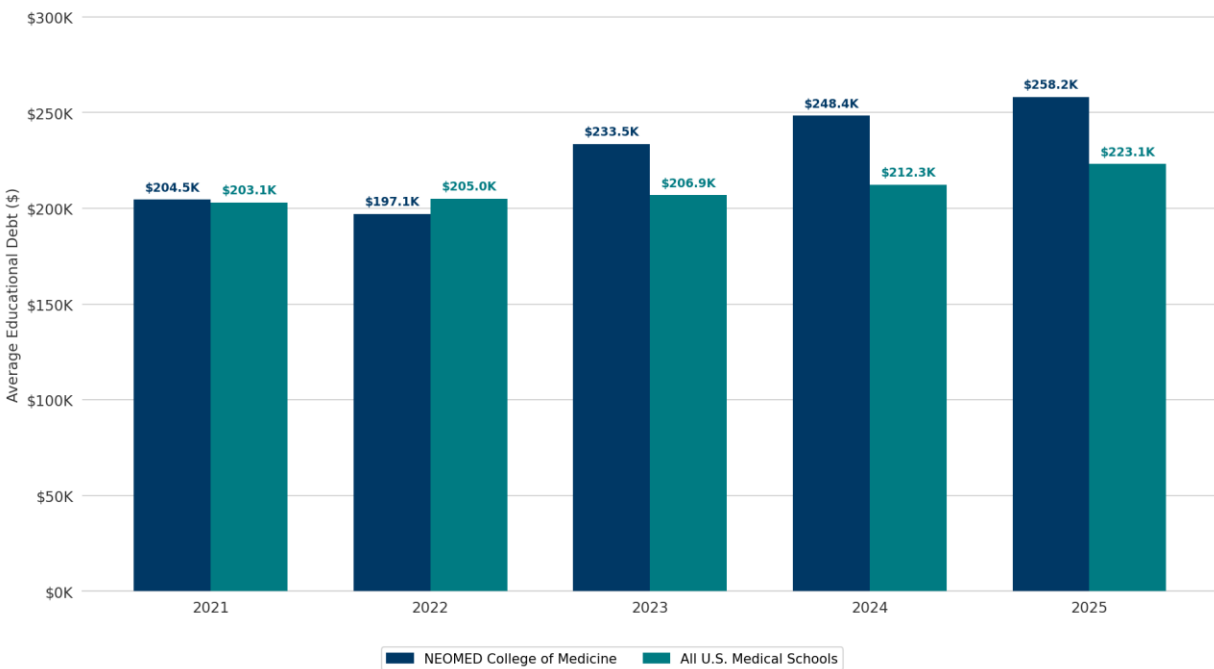


Figure 1. NEOMED College of Medicine Average Educational Debt vs. All U.S. Medical Schools — Grouped Bar Chart, Graduation Years 2021 through 2025. Navy bars = NEOMED College of Medicine; Teal bars = All U.S. Medical Schools.
