Figure 1. College of Medicine Average MCAT Composite Scores Over Past 5 Academic Years

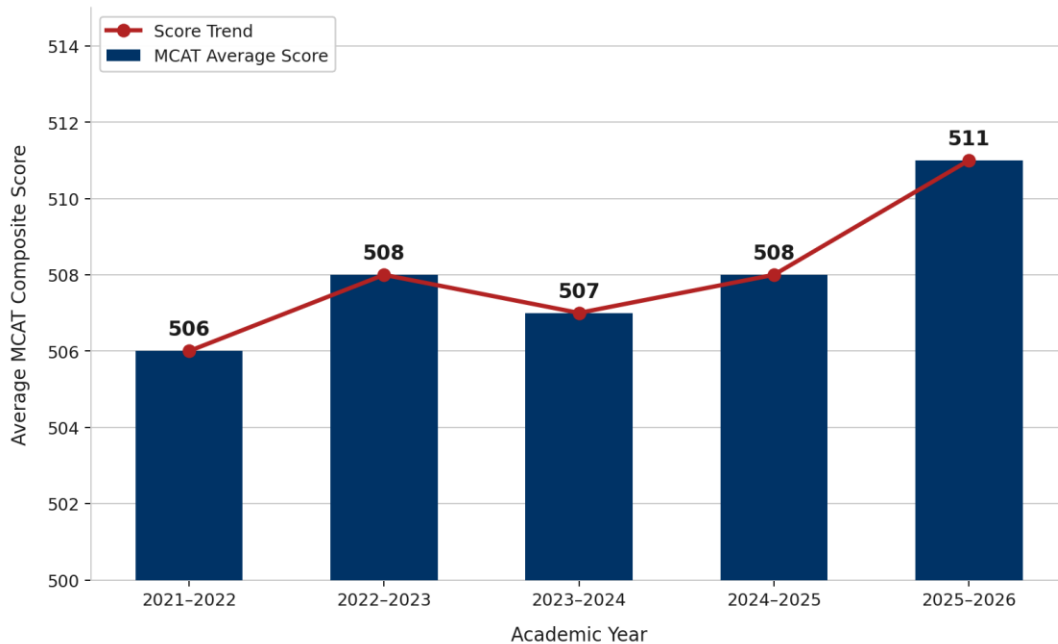


Figure 1. College of Medicine average MCAT composite scores from AY 2021–2022 to AY 2025–2026. Data labels above each bar show the numeric average score per year. The red trend line highlights the directional increase over the five-year period.
