Introduction

This document presents first-attempt pass rate data for two United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) components administered to Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) students, compared against national passing percentages. Data covers the most recent five calendar years available for each exam and are presented using both a data visualization and an accessible data table.

USMLE Step 1 — First Attempt Pass Rates

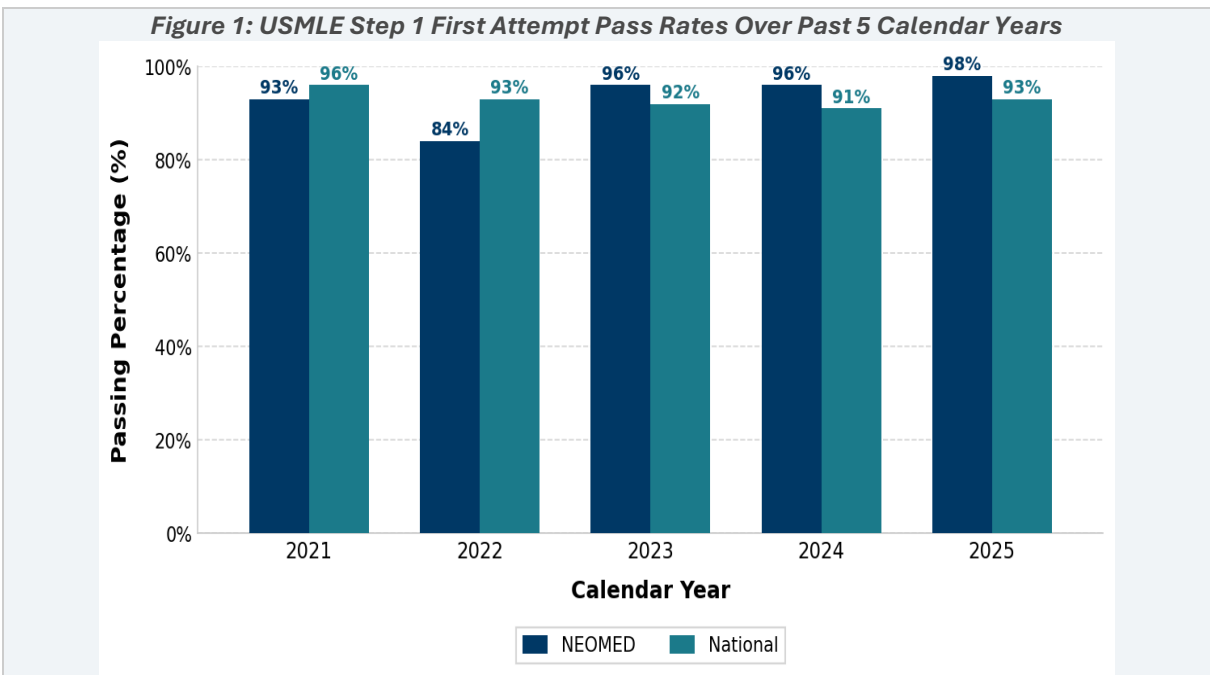


Figure 1. College of Medicine USMLE Step 1 First Attempt Pass Rates — NEOMED vs. National (Calendar Years 2021–2025). Dark navy bars represent NEOMED; teal bars represent National averages.

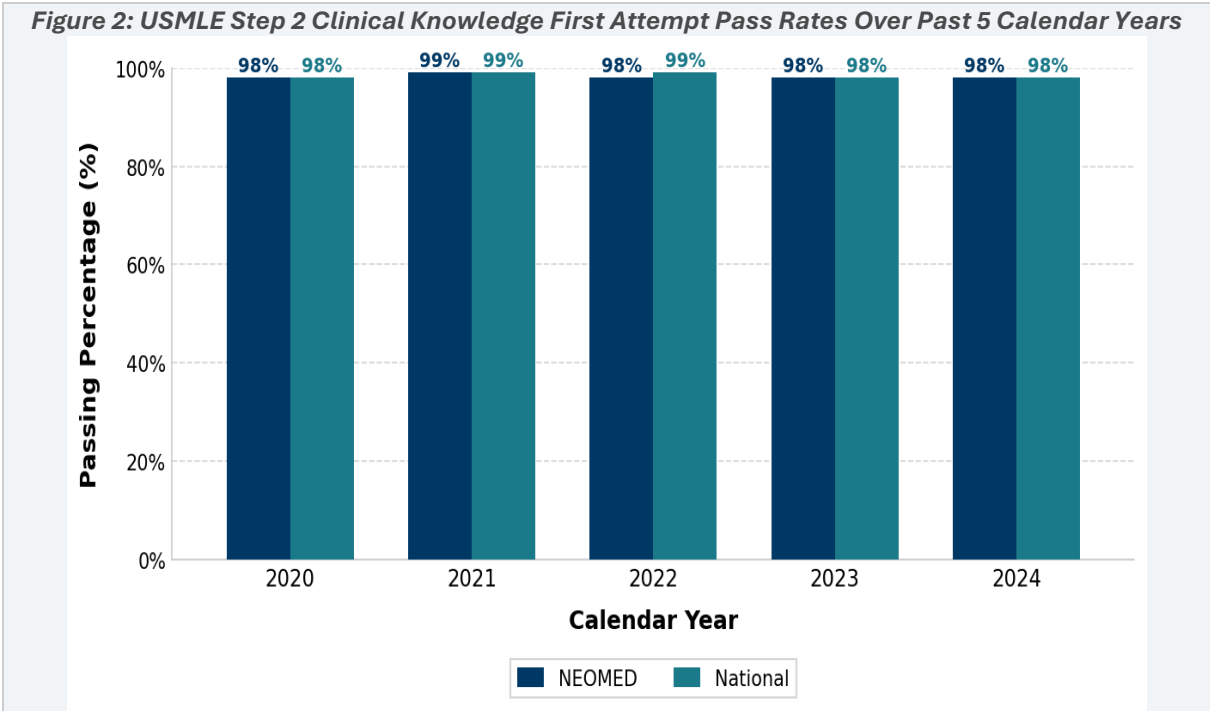


Figure 2. USMLE Step 2 Clinical Knowledge First Attempt Pass Rates — NEOMED vs. National (Calendar Years 2020–2024). Dark navy bars represent NEOMED; teal bars represent National averages.
