Introduction

This report presents College of Pharmacy applicant, matriculant, and enrollment data for Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) across five academic years, from 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Data are drawn from official Fall Census enrollment records and admissions data.

COP Applicants and Matriculants by Academic Year

The visualization below uses a combo chart format. Grouped bars display the total number of applicants (navy) and matriculants (teal) for each academic year. A dashed amber trend line connects the matriculant values to highlight change over time.

FIGURE 1: Applicant and Matriculant Trends Over Past 5 Academic Years

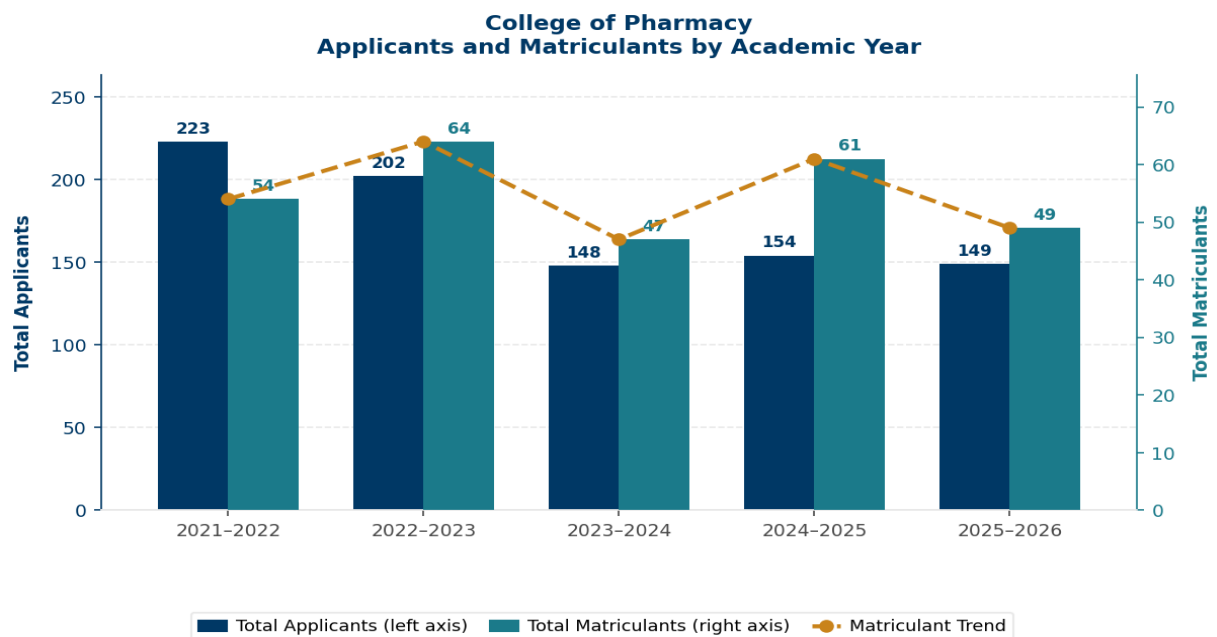


Figure 1. College of Pharmacy — Total Applicants and Matriculants, 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Bars represent applicant (navy) and matriculant (teal) counts per academic year. Dashed amber line shows the matriculant trend. The complete data set is provided in Table 1.

The dashed amber line and labeled data points show total enrollment, making overall growth easy to track alongside the gender breakdown.

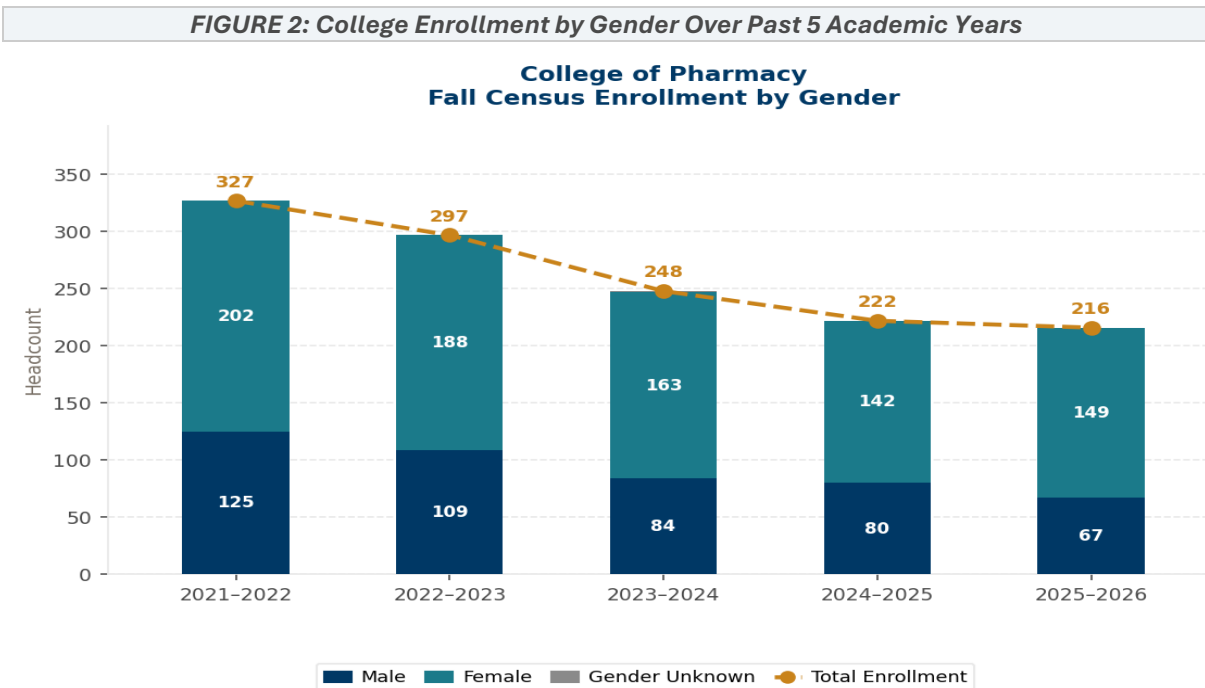


Figure 2. College of Pharmacy — Fall Census Enrollment by Gender, 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Stacked bars represent Male (navy), Female (teal), and Gender Unknown (gray) enrollment counts per academic year. Dashed amber line indicates total enrollment. The complete data set is provided in Table 2.
