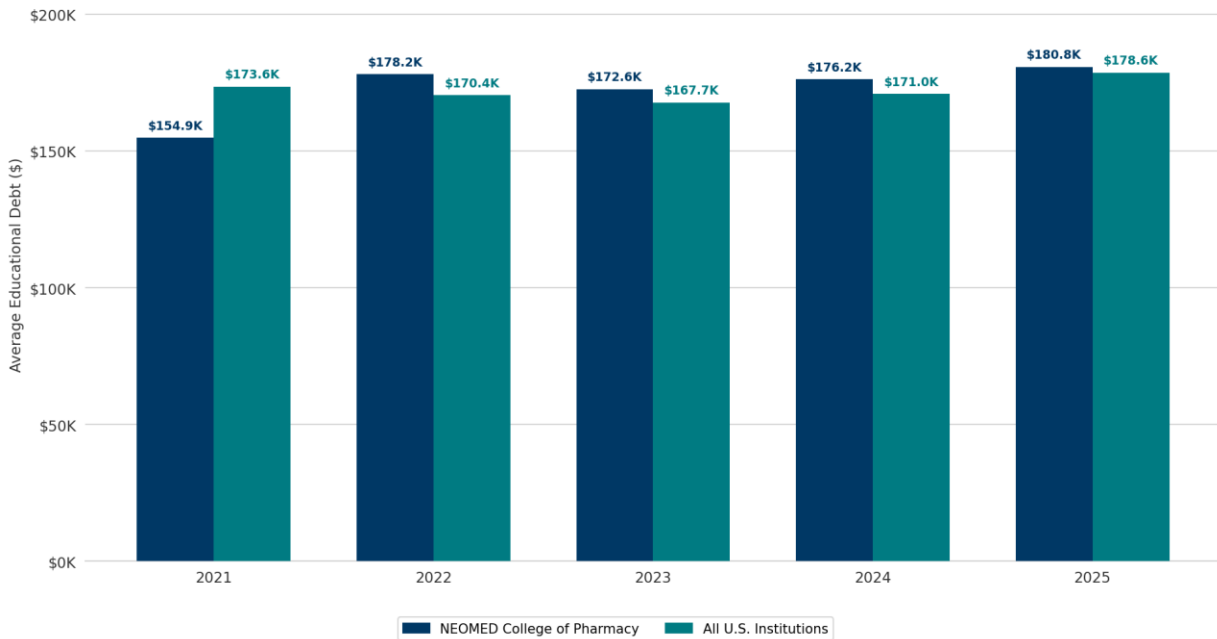
## Introduction

This report presents average educational debt data for graduates of the NEOMED College of Pharmacy across five graduation years, from 2021 through 2025. Data are drawn from official university records and national surveys.
