FIGURE 1: COP Graduate Career Choice Satisfaction (%) Over Past 5 Academic Years

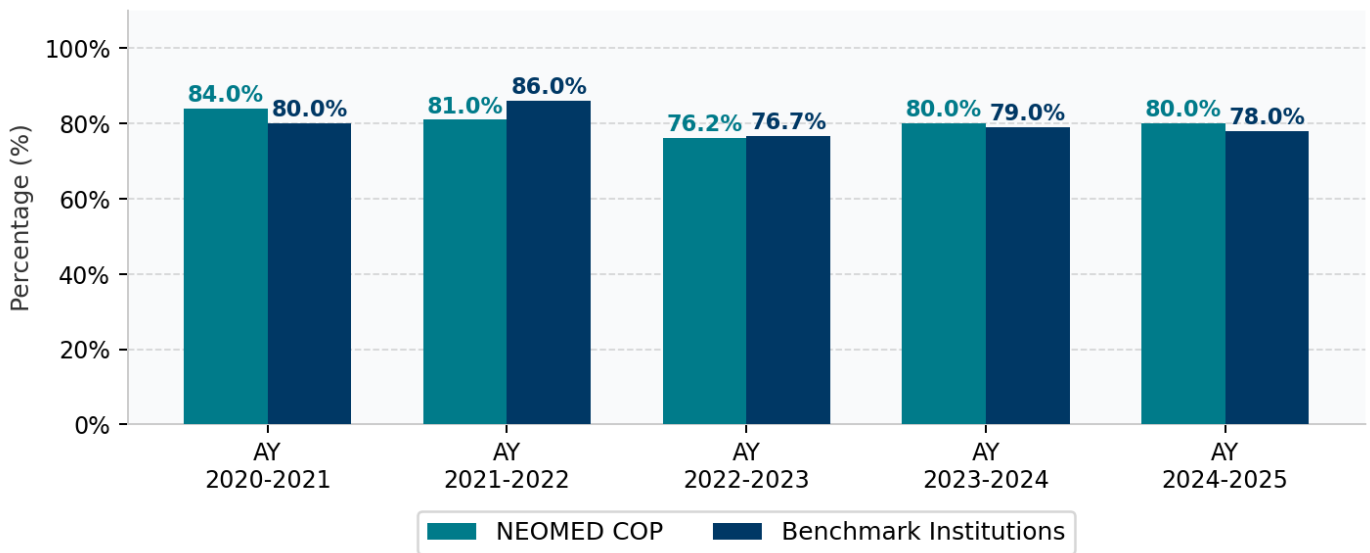


Figure 1: College of Pharmacy — Graduate Career Choice Satisfaction (%) by Academic Year, AY 2020-2021 through AY 2024-2025. Teal bars represent NEOMED COP; navy bars represent Benchmark Institutions. Detailed data are provided in Table 1.

FIGURE 2: COP Graduate Preparedness to Enter Pharmacy Practice (%) Over Past 5 Academic Years

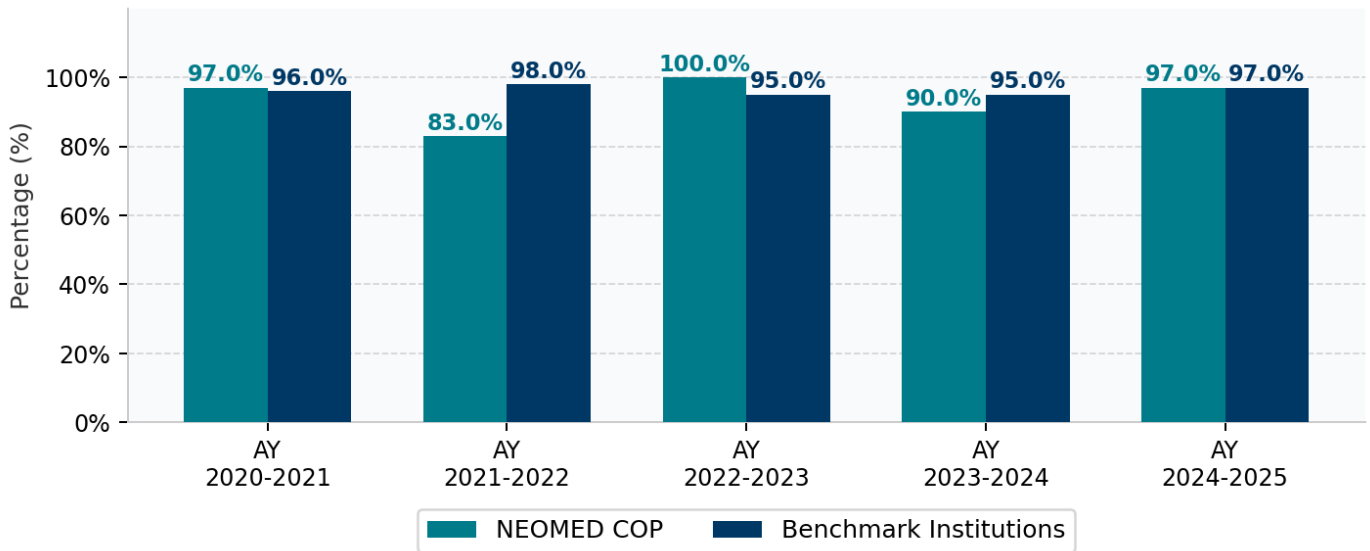


Figure 2: College of Pharmacy — Graduate Preparedness to Enter Pharmacy Practice (%) by Academic Year, AY 2020-2021 through AY 2024-2025. Teal bars represent NEOMED COP; navy bars represent Benchmark Institutions. Detailed data are provided in Table 1.
