Introduction

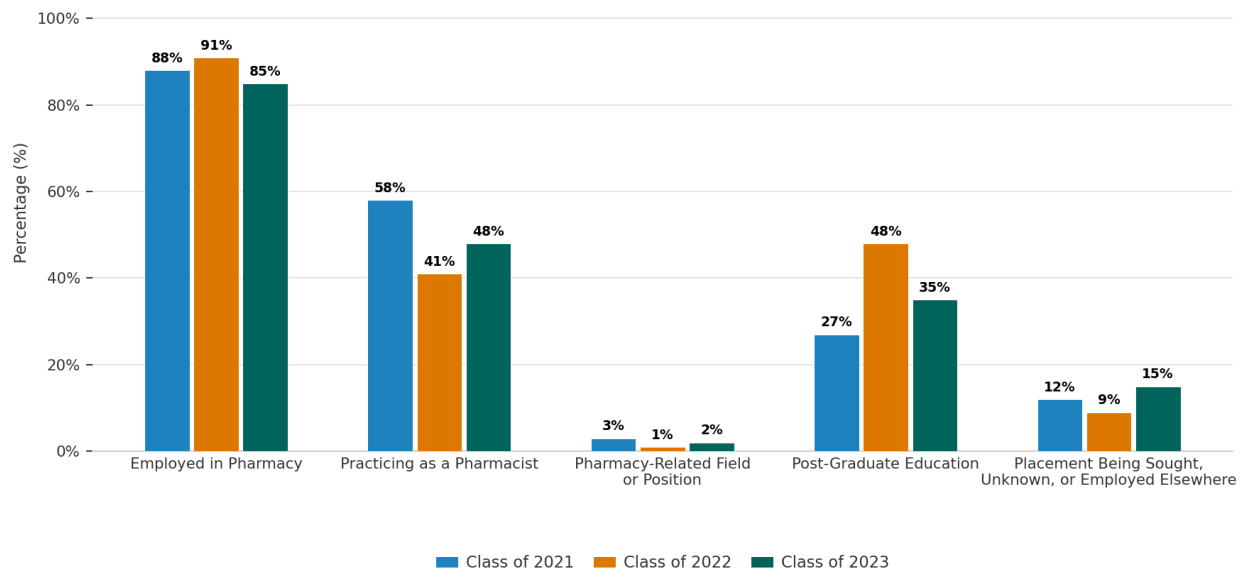
This document presents job placement and residency match outcomes for College of Pharmacy graduates across three consecutive graduating classes (2021–2023). Data are expressed as percentages of graduates who were placed in each position type, practice location, or residency category.

**Job placement data is collected via the College of Pharmacy Job Placement survey 6–9 months post-graduation.*

Position and Employment Outcomes

The figure and table below display the percentage of each graduating class placed in each of five position and employment categories. Percentages represent the proportion of students in each graduating class who reported the noted employment outcome.

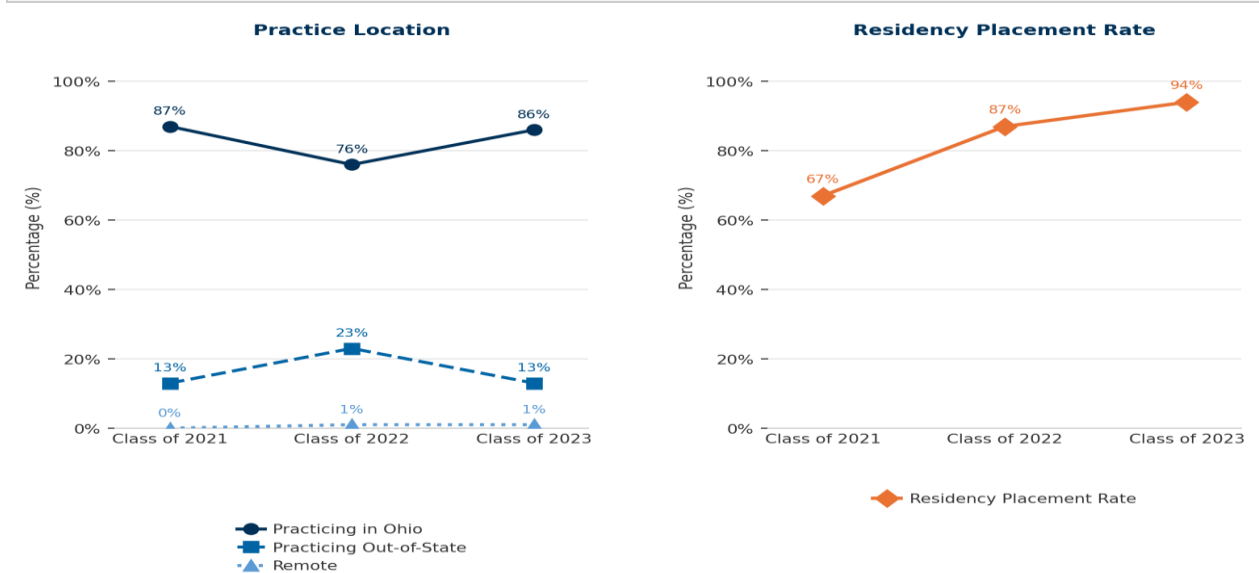

Placement Being Sought, Unknown, or Employed Elsewhere	12%	9%	15%

Practice Location and Residency Placement Trends

The figure and table below display two sets of metrics across the three most recent graduating classes: (1) the percentage of graduates practicing in Ohio, out-of-state, or remotely (Practice Location), and (2) the residency placement rate for each class (Residency Placement Rate).

Table 2: Practice location and residency placement rate trends for the most recent three College of Pharmacy graduating classes. “Practicing in Ohio” and “Practicing Out-of-State” reflect the geographic distribution of employed graduates. “Remote” reflects graduates in a remote practice position. “Residency Placement Rate” reflects the percentage of graduates who matched into a pharmacy residency program. All percentages are rounded to the nearest whole number.
