

# University Faculty and Staff Headcounts

Academic Years 2021–2022 through 2025–2026

## Introduction

This report presents faculty and staff headcount data for Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) across five academic years, from 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Data are drawn from official Human Resources (HR) Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) records, with a data capture date of November 1st for each reporting year.

Headcount figures are disaggregated by staff type and employment status. Instructional staff are reported separately by full-time status (further disaggregated between Non-Medical School and Medical School faculty) and part-time status. Non-instructional staff are reported by full-time and part-time status.

## Instructional Staff Headcounts

The visualization below presents a grouped bar chart comparing Full-Time Instructional Staff (Non-Medical School), Full-Time Instructional Staff (Medical School), and Part-Time Instructional Staff for each of the five academic years from 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. A dashed amber trend line plots the Total Instructional Staff headcount over the same period. Each bar is labeled with its exact headcount value. The complete underlying data are provided in Table 1.

**FIGURE 1: Instructional Staff Headcounts by Employment Type Over Past 5 Academic Years**

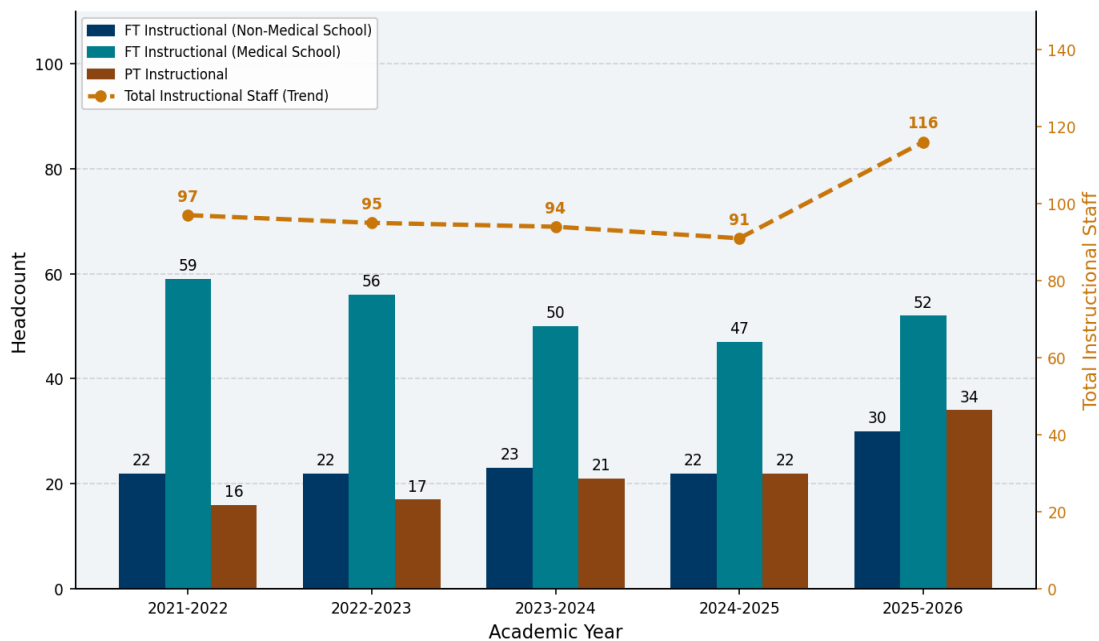


Figure 1. NEOMED HR IPEDS Instructional Staff Headcounts by Employment Type — Grouped Bar Chart with Total Trend Line, Academic Years 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Navy bars = FT Instructional (Non-Medical School); Teal bars = FT Instructional (Medical School); Brown bars = PT Instructional; Dashed amber line = Total Instructional Staff.

**FIGURE 2: Non-Instructional Staff Headcounts by Employment Status Over Past 5 Academic Years**

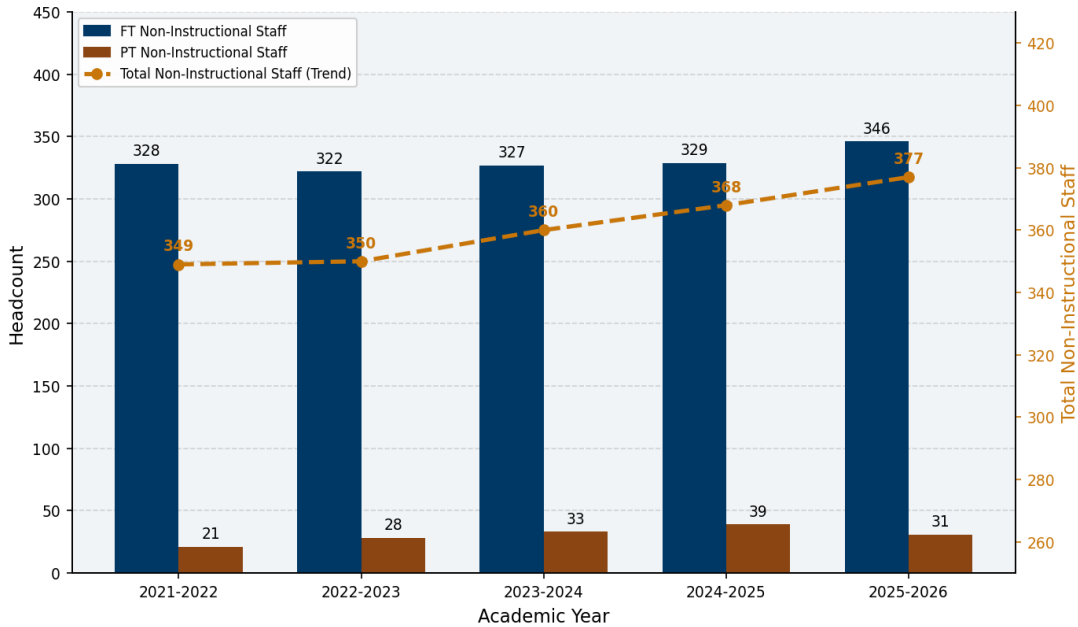


Figure 2. NEOMED HR IPEDS Non-Instructional Staff Headcounts by Employment Status — Grouped Bar Chart with Total Trend Line, Academic Years 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Navy bars = FT Non-Instructional Staff; Brown bars = PT Non-Instructional Staff; Dashed amber line = Total Non-Instructional Staff.

**FIGURE 3: Grand Total Staff Headcount Trend Over Past 5 Academic Years**

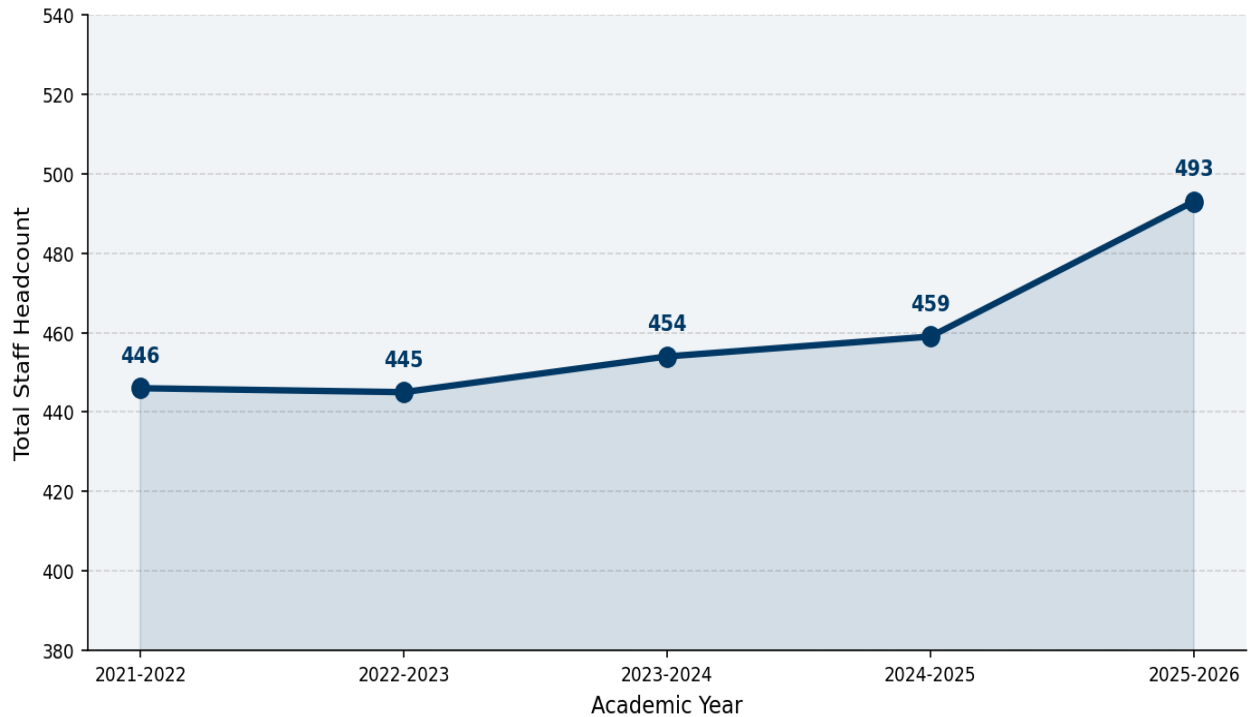


Figure 3. NEOMED HR IPEDS Grand Total Staff Headcount Trend — Line Graph, Academic Years 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Grand Total Staff = Total Instructional Staff + Total Non-Instructional Staff.
