Introduction

This report presents College of Graduate Studies enrollment data for Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) across five academic years, from 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Data are drawn from official Fall Census enrollment records.

Fall Census College Enrollment by Gender

The visualization below uses a stacked bar chart with a total enrollment trend line. Each bar is divided into segments representing Male (navy), Female (teal), and Gender Unknown (gray) students, with each segment labeled with its exact headcount. The dashed amber line and labeled data points show total enrollment, making overall growth easy to track alongside the gender breakdown.

FIGURE 1: College Enrollment by Gender Over Past 5 Academic Years

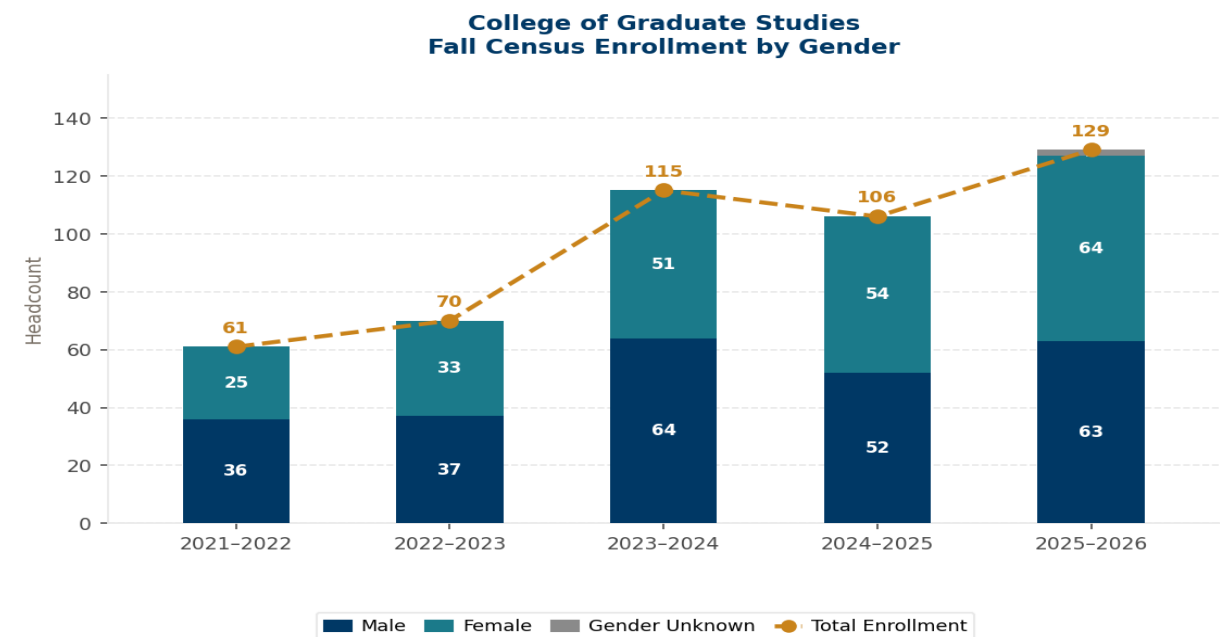


Figure 1. College of Graduate Studies — Fall Census Enrollment by Gender, 2021–2022 through 2025–2026. Stacked bars represent Male (navy), Female (teal), and Gender Unknown (gray) enrollment counts per academic year. Dashed amber line indicates total enrollment. The complete data set is provided in Table 1 below.
