

Watanakunakorn Student Fellowships in Infectious Disease

In recognition of the generous support from Dr. Chatrchai Watanakunakorn and Mrs. Eleanor Watanakunakorn, donors to the NEOMED Foundation, the College of Medicine is proud to offer three fellowships focused on infectious disease for students who are members of the Infectious Disease Interest Group (IDIG). These fellowships aim to further the academic development of NEOMED students with a passion for the field of infectious disease. Proposals may be submitted to Feng Dong, M.D., Ph.D. at fdong@neomed.edu.

1. Infectious Disease Fellowship (IDF)

Each fellowship provides \$3,000* to students as a stipend to engage in clinical or laboratory work related to infectious disease in any of NEOMED's colleges or hospitals for the duration of approximately 8-10 weeks. Students are required to present their results at an annual NEOMED student poster session. This fellowship is open to any NEOMED student who is a member of the Infectious Disease Interest Group.

**More than one fellowship may be available based on available funding.*

2. Small Grant ID Fellowship (SGF)

This grant provides \$1,500* for supplies/resource funding for students involved in clinical and/or discovery aspects of infectious disease. This grant can be paired with an IDF but is not a requirement. Students who desire to complete a project related to infectious disease are also eligible.

3. Travel Fellowship (TF)

Each Fellowship provides \$3,000* for a student to attend and present research results (either oral or poster format) at a national conference on a subject related to infectious disease. Presenting at such a conference is a requirement for funding under this fellowship.
